Thank you so much for your support during this past year. With your help we were able to place close to 100 Scholarships in 2018, a significant increase on previous years. As before, we've been able to support a fantastic group of young people as they start their time at university, and our survey of students again shows that the Scholarships really do make a big difference to their first year.
